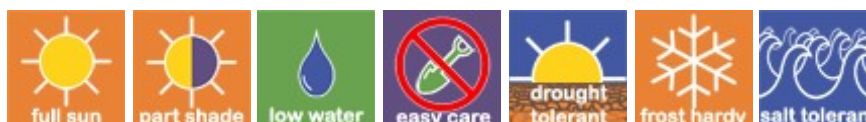

callistemon citrinus 'White Anzac'

A low, spreading shrub with pure white flower spikes in spring and early summer. Grows to 1m in height and spreads up to 3m.



origin

NSW

cultural notes

A hardy and vigorous plant adaptable to a wide range of conditions. Prefers full sun but will tolerate light shade.

maintenance

Can be pruned after flowering to maintain shape.

tolerates

Tolerant of drought, frost salt spray and poor drainage.

flowering season

Spring and early Summer.

flower colour

Pure white, ageing to cream-white, bottlebrush style flower spikes to 15cm in length.

foliage colour

Mid green to dark green lanceolate leaves to 6cm in length.

width

up to 3m

height

up to 1m

plant spacing

150cm apart

recommended uses

An attractive fast growing plant suitable as a small hedge, mounding groundcover, or as a container plant.
