## Correa pulchella 'White Tips'

### correa pulchella 'White Tips'

A small evergreen shrub that can vary in form from semi-prostrate to erect and 1.5m in height. Leaves are green and oval in shape. Flowers are tubular and pink with white tips.

## cultural notes

A hardy plant that prefers full sun or part shade and well drained soil.

## maintenance

Can be pruned to maintain shape and promote a dense habit.

## tolerates

Tolerant of drought and frost.

## flowering season

Winter.

## flower colour

Pink flowers with white tips. Flowers are tubular and pendulous.

## foliage colour

Foliage colour can vary between dark and light green. Leaves are oval in shape and shiny.

## width

up to 1.5m

## height

up to 1.5m

## plant spacing

100cm apart

## recommended uses

This is considered one of the prettiest of the Correa species and is suitable for mass planting or as a feature. Also makes an excellent pot plant.
