

#### common rush

ornamental semi-aquatic rush with attractive summer flowers

bog gardens coastal gardens suited to pots origin nsw, qld, wa, sa, tas, vic, act

cultural notes full sun, boggy conditions, fast growing, long lived, very

hardy

project type maintenance may be pruned annually to remove old foliage

urban and commercial

residential wetland

erosion control

tolerates inundations and periodic dry periods

flowering season spring to autumn

flower colour brown branching clustered, 5cm from leaf tip

ecosystem type

foliage colour dark green with golden brown tinge at base of stems,

cylindrical leaves

woodland wetland riparian

height up to 1m

water depth aquatic to 0.25m

soil type and drainage

plant spacing 30cm apart

light - sandy soils medium - loamy soils heavy - clay soils reasonable drainage poor drainage

**recommended uses** great for stabilising dam and river banks, ideal for decorative ponds, provides habitat for water birds
