leptospermum 'Pink Cascade'

Thought to be a hybrid between *Leptospermum polygalifolium* 'Pacific Beauty' and *Leptospermum continentale*. A spreading shrub with an arching or weeping habit, growing to 80cm in height and spreading 1.5m. Profuse pink flowers are borne in spring.

origin

Hybrid species.

cultural notes

Will tolerate a range of soils but is happiest in moist soils with good drainage. Grow in full sun or part shade.

maintenance

Can be pruned lightly to maintain shape.

tolerates

Frost and drought tolerant.

flowering season

Spring and Summer.

flower colour

Pink flowers to 20mm in diameter are borne along the arching stems.

foliage colour

Narrow lance-shaped leaves grow to 15mm in length and are mid to dark green in colour.

width

up to 1.5m

height

up to 0.8m

plant spacing

50cm apart

recommended uses

A useful feature plant or in rockeries or for growing over retaining walls.
