

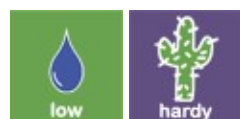

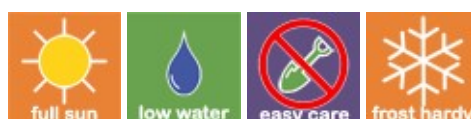
plant type

**Carex gaudichaudiana****tufted sedge**

tough loosely tufted sedge, excellent ornamental feature in wetland plantings

urban and commercial

nsw, qld, wa, sa, tas, vic, act

cultural notes

full sun, boggy conditions, fast growing, long lived, very hardy

maintenance

may be pruned annually to remove old foliage

ecosystem type

wetland

tolerates

inundations and periodic dry periods

flowering season

spring to autumn

soil type and drainage

medium - loamy soils
heavy - clay soils
poor drainage

flower colour

brown clustered flower spikes

foliage colour

dark green, rough textured and sharp edge leaf blades

height

up to 1m

water depth

aquatic to 0.25m

plant spacing

50cm apart

recommended uses

ornamental sedge used in constructed wetlands and provides habitat for water birds. May be used for poolside plantings
