<b>description</b>	Compact, hardy and long lived
<b>maintenance</b>	Remove thatch to promote new growth. Water every 4 weeks in arid conditions
<b>care</b>	Water as needed for first 2 - 3 months until established. Best results in mulched gardens. Apply slow release fertiliser once a year in spring
<b>tolerates</b>	Light frost, moderate drought conditions
<b>flowering</b>	Spring through to summer
<b>flower colour</b>	Charming display of lilac flowers that transition to a spray of purple berries
<b>position</b>	Performs well in both full sun and shady environments in most soil conditions
<b>height x width</b>	30cm x 20 cm in full sun
<b>spacing</b>	25cm apart for mass planting. 40cm apart for specimen planting
<b>uses</b>	Specimen, mass and border plantings, rockeries, container plant
