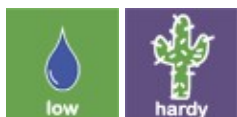


**plant type**

### bergalia tussock

Tussock forming sedge growing to a height of 60cm. Long gracefully arching seed heads.

Eastern NSW, Vic.

**cultural notes**

Grow in full sun. Natural habitat is along watercourses and in low-lying areas where water collects.

**maintenance**

Remove spent seed heads, can be cut back periodically.

**tolerates**

Frost

**flowering season**

Spring and Summer

**width**

up to 0.4m

**height**

up to 0.6m

**water depth**

edges and marshland

**recommended uses**

Moist areas and at the edge of ponds and watercourses.
