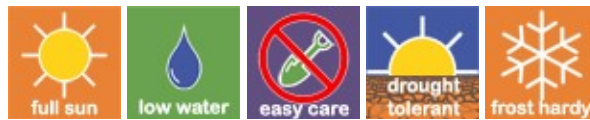
Chrysocephalum apiculatum

tufted upright or creeping perennial with attractive clusters of yellow flowers



water hardiness



top ten

butterfly attracting
coastal gardens
flowers and showy seed heads
frost tolerant
shady gardens
small plants for small gardens

origin	Australia wide
cultural notes	full sun, most soil conditions, likes a dry position, fast growing, very hardy
maintenance	may be pruned annually to maintain compact growth and remove spent flower heads
tolerates	drought conditions
flowering season	throughout the year, most commonly from later winter to spring
flower colour	clusters of bright yellow flowers
foliage colour	silver grey downy foliage
height	up to 0.2m
recommended uses	ornamental, ideal for landscaping and mass planting. Also excellent in rockeries and hanging baskets
