leafy flat sedge

tough sedge, great for ornamental pond

flowers and showy seed heads suited to pots

origin	nsw, qld, tas, vic, act
cultural notes	full sun, boggy conditions, long lived, very hardy
maintenance	may be pruned annually to remove old foliage
tolerates	Frost, inundations and periodic dry periods
flowering season	spring to autumn
flower colour	brown clustered flowers appear on long triangular shaped stem
foliage colour	mid green, coarse texture
height	up to 1.3m
water depth	edges and marshland
plant spacing	50cm apart
recommended uses	pond/dam/river plantings and is also an excellent ornamental plant which provides habitat for birds
