> cultural notes full sun, boggy conditions, in water up to 30cm deep, long

> > lived, very hardy

spring to autumn

No maintenance required. Dead leaves provide shelter for maintenance urban and commercial

water birds

tolerates inundations and short dry periods

ecosystem type

flowering season

wetland flower colour small cream to brown spike appear on tip of foliage

foliage colour mid to dark green, often reds at base of stems, smooth soil type and drainage

cylindrical shape with prominent mid ribs.

medium - loamy soils height up to 1m

> water depth aquatic to 0.5m

plant spacing 30cm apart

recommended uses dam and river plantings which help stabilise water edge/

banks. Also, an excellent ornamental plant for ponds

which provides habitat for water birds
