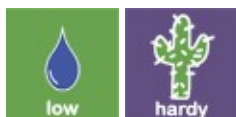

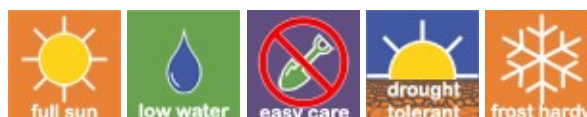

Grevillea juniperina

juniper-leaf grevillea, Prickly spider flower.

This grevillea varies in habit from a spreading semi-prostrate to a rounded upright shrub. The leaves are dark green and needle like and provide excellent protection for small birds.

origin	ACT, NSW, Qld.
cultural notes	Long lived, hardy and adaptable to a range of soils and climates. Prefers full sun but will tolerate some shade.
maintenance	Prune to maintain shape.
tolerates	Frost and drought tolerant
flowering season	Spring and Summer.
flower colour	The spider-like flowerheads vary in colour from scarlet through orange to pale yellow.
foliage colour	Needle like leaves are dark green.
width	up to 2m
height	up to 2.4m
plant spacing	100cm apart
recommended uses	Excellent habitat for small birds. A hardy plant good for mass plantings or as a feature specimen.
