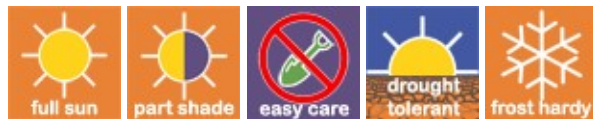
water hardiness

scaly buttons

A perennial plant growing to a height of 30cm and spreading 40cm. The flowers occur on long scaly stalks and are held well above the foliage.

cultural notes

An adaptable and hardy plant. Prefers moist but well drained soils in full sun or part shade.

soil type and drainage

light - sandy soils
medium - loamy soils
heavy - clay soils
good drainage
reasonable drainage
poor drainage

tolerates

Tolerant of frost, drought and short period of inundation.

flowering season

Spring and Summer.

flower colour

Small yellow daisy flowers on long scaly stalks.

foliage colour

Linear leaves are dark green above and woolly white underneath and form small tufts around the flower stem.

width

up to 0.4m

height

up to 0.3m

plant spacing

20cm apart

recommended uses

A hardy plant suitable for rockeries, cottage gardens, mass plantings or as a container plant.
