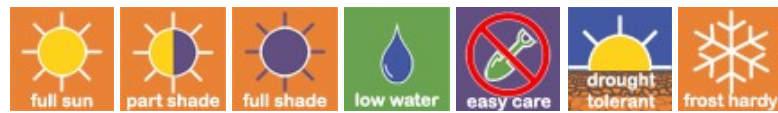
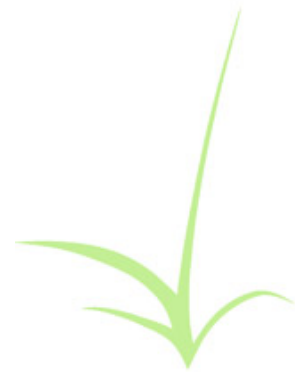

Leptospermum brevipes

Slender tea tree

A large spreading shrub with a pendulous habit, growing to 4m in height and 3m in width. White flowers, 12mm in diameter occur in spring and summer.

origin	NSW, ACT, Qld, Vic.
cultural notes	A very hardy and fast growing shrub adaptable to most soils and positions.
maintenance	Can be lightly pruned to maintain shape.
tolerates	Tolerant of drought, frost and poor soils.
flowering season	Spring and Summer.
flower colour	Profuse white flowers to 1.2cm in width.
foliage colour	Small grey green leaves to 1cm in length.
width	up to 3m
height	up to 4m
plant spacing	80cm apart
recommended uses	Useful as a screen or informal hedge plant.
