<b>origin</b>	nsw, victoria, q'ld, sa & tasmania
<b>cultural notes</b>	fast growing and very hardy and long lived. Will grow in full sun or part shade in most soil conditions
<b>maintenance</b>	may be pruned to remove spent seed heads (usually late winter) and to encourage new growth
<b>tolerates</b>	drought and frost hardy
<b>flowering season</b>	spring through to summer
<b>flower colour</b>	green light mauve seed heads maturing on burgundy stems
<b>foliage colour</b>	bright green fine leaved
<b>height</b>	up to 0.3m
<b>plant spacing</b>	30cm apart for mass planting
<b>recommended uses</b>	ornamental grass ideal for landscaping or revegetation, best effect when mass planted and also suitable as edging or border plant for beds or paths
