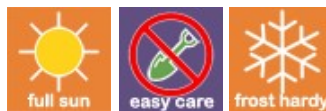

full sun in water plantings, long lived, very hardy

maintenance

prune to remove dead material and to promote new growth

ecosystem type

wetland

tolerates

inundations, frosts and short dry periods

flowering season

spring to summer

dense spikes

medium - loamy soils
heavy - clay soils
poor drainage

foliage colour

green with red bases, smooth strap like, some floating on water surface some erect

height

up to 2m

water depth

aquatic greater than 1m

plant spacing

50cm apart

recommended uses

used in water plantings and to help stabilise dams and waterways. Will grow in stationary to slow moving water ways and provides habitat for water birds. Excellent in mass plantings or as an ornamental to decorate ponds
