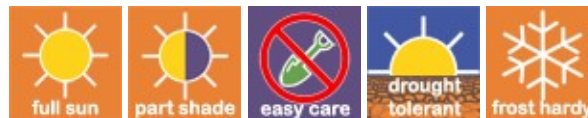
Viola hederacea

origin	nsw, act, vic, qld, tas, sa
cultural notes	full sun or part shade, most soils, very hardy
maintenance	prune to control
tolerates	frost, shady positions
flowering season	spring
flower colour	small white and purple flowers appearing on stems above the foliage
foliage colour	small soft rounded leaves
height	up to 0.2m
plant spacing	10cm apart
recommended uses	rockeries, mass plantings, pots, hanging baskets and as a groundcover
