



Acer freemanii 'Jeffersred-Autumn Blaze'

Lipstick Maple

A fast-growing, medium to large deciduous tree that is known for its luscious autumn colours. This tree has maple shaped leaves that turn a bright red in autumn and has dark grey-brown bark. Can grow up to 13 metres with an oval-shaped canopy.



Origin	Originally Cultivated in Northern America.
Size	Up to 13 metres high, Up to 10 metres wide
Cultural Notes	Low maintenance plant. Prune tree when panting to create new growth
Tolerates	Is adaptable to dry and cool climates. Tolerates most sites, both wet and dry as well as frost hardy.
Flowers / Flowering Season	Rarely Flowers.
Foliage Colour or Type	Foliage is a traditional maple shape and a rich green in summer, turning bright lipstick red in early autumn.
Soil Type	Ideally well-draining, moist soil. Prefers acidic soils.
Suited to	A great tree to create shaded areas. Good for parkland, gardens or streetscapes. Works as a great feature tree because of the luscious colours produced in autumn.
