

A small to medium tree growing to 6 metres. Can often have multiple trunks joining closer to the base with smooth bark. The canopy matures into a dome-like shape. This species can range in size, colour, foliage shape and size and other traits depending on the cultivator.

Origin Japan, Korea, and China

Size Up to 6 metres high, Up to 4 metres

Cultural Notes Very adaptable to different climate

conditions. Full sun to part shade. Fertilise when planting. If pruning is necessary, do so in a dormant period, avoid spring for this reason.

Tolerates Frost tolerant.

Flowers / Small red flowers, often unnoticed.

Flowering Season Rarely blooms.

Foliage Colour or Usually comes as a five to seven Type lobed palmate leaf. A light green

colour in spring, turning into a range of yellows, oranges, and reds

through autumn.

Soil Type Easily grown in moist, rich, slightly

acidic soil, well-draining soils
