



Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Cimmzam'

Cimmaron Ash

A medium-sized deciduous tree with a round-shaped canopy and a uniform branch structure. This species gives a beautiful array of autumnal colours ranging from yellows, reds, and burgundy. The foliage will stay on the tree well into the season, making it a perfect feature.

Origin	North America.
Size	Up to 13 metres high, Up to 8 metres wide.
Cultural Notes	Prefers full sun. When planting water in well and keep the soil moist until tree is established. Pruning can encourage new growth.
Tolerates	Is tolerant of wind and drought as well as urban conditions. Is tolerant to frost.
Flowers / Flowering Season	Insignificant, yellow-green flowers. Flowers in spring.
Foliage Colour or Type	Foliage is green, sprouting later in Spring and turning yellows, reds and burgundy through Autumn. Won't fall until late into the season.
Soil Type	Prefers well-draining, moist soil. Humus rich soil is preferred.
Suited to	Ideal tree to feature a streetscape or avenue or put it in your garden for a bit of colour.
