



Lagerstroemia indica 'Biloxi'

Crepe Myrtle Pale Pink

Known for its clusters of frilly pink flowers. This is a deciduous tree that only grows to a small height in a Vase-like shape. A perfect tree for smaller gardens.



Origin	South China, Korea, India.
Size	Up to 8 metres high, Up to 5 metres wide.
Cultural Notes	Pruning regularly will help promote further flowering. Prefers full sun with well-draining soil. Steer away from planting near waterways due to the littering from the tree.
Tolerates	Tolerates drought once established. Tolerant of constricted roots, works well in small areas. This tree grows well in coastal areas, being tolerant to sandy and salty conditions.
Flowers / Flowering Season	Flowers come in bundles or clusters of small crinkled petals. They are a dusty pink colour and flower through spring and summer.
Foliage Colour or Type	Foliage is a bright green and will turn a copper-orange colour in autumn.
Soil Type	Rich with humus soil that is well-draining is preferred. Can tolerate most pH levels.
Suited to	This tree is a fantastic feature tree due to its beautiful flowering. It was well in small gardens or nature strips because of its smaller size.
