Known for its clusters of frilly pink flowers. This is a deciduous tree that only grows to a small height in a Vase-like shape. A perfect tree for smaller gardens.

| Origin | South China, Korea, India. |

| Size | Up to 8 metres high, Up to 5 metres wide. |
| Cultural Notes | Pruning regularly will help promote further flowering. Prefers full sun with well-draining soil. Steer away from planting near waterways due to the littering from the tree. |
| Tolerates | Tolerates drought once established. Tolerant of constricted roots, works well in small areas. This tree grows well in coastal areas, being tolerant to sandy and salty conditions. |
| Flowers / Flowering Season | Flowers come in bundles or clusters of small crinkled petals. They are a dusty pink colour and flower through spring and summer. |
| Foliage Colour or Type | Foliage is a bright green and will turn a copper-orange colour in autumn. |
| Soil Type | Rich with humus soil that is well-draining is preferred. Can tolerate most pH levels. |
| Suited to | This tree is a fantastic feature tree due to its beautiful flowering. It was well in small gardens or nature strips because of its smaller size. |
