



Pyrus calleryana 'Bradford'

Ornamental Pear 'Bradford'

This deciduous ornamental pear is a medium tree with an oval-shaped canopy. White flowers will cover the canopy through spring. Foliage is glossy and green, turning hues of reds and oranges through autumn.

Origin	China, Vietnam.
Size	Up to 12 metres high, Up to 9 metres wide.
Cultural Notes	Does best in full sun. Hardy and suitable for a wide range of climate conditions. A low maintenance tree. Will attract birds and other flora. Pruning can occur in Winter if needed.
Tolerates	Is tolerable of drought and clay soils.
Flowers / Flowering Season	Flowering is prolific, the tree becoming covered with creamy white flowers in spring. Flowers followed by small, green fruits.
Foliage Colour or Type	Foliage is a light green turning into rich oranges and reds through autumn until falling.
Soil Type	Prefers well-draining soil, most soil types and pH levels are tolerated.
Suited to	This tree is perfect in large gardens or parklands and works well for creating good shade.
