

A small deciduous plum with a V-shaped canopy. The foliage has the colour of bright green through summer, turning rust-red in autumn. Through spring, there is a large production of pale pink double flowers that are present down the branches.

Origin Africa, Asia.

Size Up to 5 metres high, Up to 4 metres

wide.

Cultural Notes Prefers full sun to part shade. This

tree can grow in containers, suitable for areas with limited soil available.

Tolerates Tolerant of frost once established.
